The new pistol range is getting a work out and we easily held our NRA Basic Pistol/Practical Pistol on the range. Many thanks to Tully Rinckey Law Firm (see the back page ads) for sponsoring the class and providing ammo, saving the club some money especially considering today's ammo prices. We are in the process of finishing up an NRA Grant Application for covered firing positions on the pistol range. If approved, the plan is to cover the entire 70' of firing line and pour cement floors. The grants will be awarded in early 2011 for spring 2011 work. Thanks to Ray Jacques for doing a superb work up and set of plans for this project.

Ray is also the member who has built the great new shooting benches on the rifle range, he is truly a craftsman.

We still need volunteers for providing food at the membership meetings. We're covered for September but we need someone looking forward into the fall. The club covers all

NTS R & G FAQs

Can non-members hunt the club grounds?

No. Hunting on club grounds is for members only.

What are the shooting hours at the club on the outside range?

Shooting may not begin until 9:00a.m. No shots should be fired after dusk. Often times it is too dark to fire at the posted sunset time.

Let's NOT disturb the neighbors.

Can I use a shotgun or pistol on the rifle range?

Yes, under certain conditions.

1- Shotgun - slugs only- **NO BIRDSHOT**

2 - Pistol - Only long range sighting in is acceptable. **Pistols should NOT be used as a matter of course.**

Remember that bottles, cans, mini-kegs and any other type of junk are NOT acceptable targets on any of the ranges.

The dumpster is intended for club use only. Members depositing household garbage or

demolition debris will be subject to disciplinary action.
