SAFETY: Shooters must provide and wear their own eye and ear protection.

TEAM ENTRIES: Team matches are unfired and consist of each member's national match score from each caliber. Teams compete for an open award only - there will be no teams within class and category. Team score will be forwarded to NYSRPA for state ranking and awards.

CLASSES: **A minimum of (5) competitors are required to constitute a class and a minimum of (5) are required for a separate category within a class.** The combining of classes and/or categories is within the discretion of the sponsor. Lower classes will be combined with higher classes to form a class per above rule, except that if fewer than 5 High Masters are present, High Masters will not be combined with any other classes and will compete for Open Awards only. The regular NRA classification system will be used, consisting of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, and Marksman. Unclassified competitors and competitors without proof of classification will fire in the Master Class. NRA temporary score books will be accepted as proof of classification.

AWARDS: Awards will be given in cash. Sponsor's awards are as follows: Open Awards, Match Winner in each Match. Open Match Winners are not eligible for class and category awards. Class and category awards are as follows: first place in class and category. A second-place in class and category will be awarded if there are at least 11 competitors. A third-place award requires 21 competitors in class and category (see CLASSES above for consolidation rules). Sponsor will provide the following special awards. High Junior, High Senior, High Grand Senior, and High Woman in the Match. Only one team award Match Winner will be awarded, providing two teams are mustered.

The following awards will be provided by New York State Rifle and Pistol Association: Open Champion and/or High Resident, First High Master, 1st Master, 1st Expert, 1st Sharpshooter, 1st Marksman, High Service/Police, High Senior (60+), High Grand Senior (70+), High Woman, High Junior, New York State Team Champions.

CHALLENGES: Challenges will be per NRA rules. A \$2.00 fee per challenge will be charged and returned if challenge is up held.

COURSE OF FIRE: All slow fire at 50 yards on B-6 targets; timed and rapid fire at 25 yards on B-8 targets. Range is equipped with turning targets at 25 yards.
