Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! I hope you were successful this past hunting season. Remember that tree stands MUST be removed from club grounds. **No exceptions**. The grounds committee will be charged with removing any that find remaining.

Non payment by January 1 will remove you from the active roster and add a \$50 late fee if not paid by the February meeting. After the February meeting you must reapply for membership with all assessments and fees.
